- I. Graduation Requirements
 - 1. A minimum study period of three years and at least 20 publication points.
 - 2. At least one publication must belong to class A.
- II. Rules for Ranking Papers and Calculating Publication Points
 - 1. The rules of journal classification and publication point calculations are listed in the attachment.
 - 2. Classification of unknown or new journals is decided by the control group meeting and approved in the Department and Institute General Meeting.

Class A: 10 publication points/paper

- 1. All IEEE, IET, SIAM, and ASME journals
- 2. Journals listed in SCI or SCI Expanded with their Impact Factors higher than the aforementioned journals (The Journal Citation Reports in the year of enrollment should be adopted while applying the rule to classify a journal.)

Class B: 4 publication points/paper

- 1. International conference papers
- 2. Domestic Journal: Journal of the Chinese Institute of Engineers

Class C: 2 publication points/paper

1. Domestic conference papers
